In terms of rule 6(1) of the J&K Civil Services (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990 Sanction is hereby accorded to the reimbursement of medical expenses in favour of Sh. 3. Certificate from Nodal Officer PM-JAY-SEHAT Scheme categorically stating therein that the said treatment is not covered under PM-JAY-SEHAT Scheme, if yes, an amount of Rs. 5.00 lakhs on account of PM-JAY-SEHAT Scheme may be deducted from the total expenditure incurred.
4. Follow-up(s), if any, is/are regulated under rules.
