- 2. the funds shall be regulated in accordance with the provisions of GFR, 2017 read with Department of Expenditure, Govt. of India's order No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 regarding registration of File No. HUD-PLAN0CSS/14/2022-Planning HQUSING &URBAN DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT I/111205/2022 bidders from a country which shares a land border with India and SCM guidelines.
- 3. the release of funds does not confer the sanction to incur the expenditure which should be booked only after observing all codal formalities.
- 4. the amount will be used as a tied grant and kept in the City Level SPV Srinagar/Jammu Smart City Ltd) in a separate Grant Fund Account created exclusively for Smart Cities Mission
- 5. this amount shall be transferred electronically through PFMS to the Bank Accounts of the implementing agencies;

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- 6. the money will be utilized strictly in accordance with the Mission Guidelines and for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned.
- 7. the SNA will furnish UC in respect of funds released at an early date in the prescribed Performa as provided in the SCM guidelines.
- 8. the funds shall be utilized for execution of the scheme strictly as per originally approved components which have been technically sanctioned and administratively approved by the Competent Authority viz-a-viz approved activity-wise works programme as detailed in Annexure-A to this Order and according to GOI's prescribed guidelines;

- 14. the physical and financial progress report along with Utilization Certificate of the funds released shall be furnished as early as possible and definitely well before 31.3.2023 to GOI, with a copy to Finance Department.
