Date :- 27 - 07 - 2004

Sanction is hereby accorded to the approval of the following criteria for declaring any local area as municipal.

- a:- The local area must have a minimum population of 5,000 as recorded in the last Census.
- b:- A tourist or pilgrim town with a local population below 5,000 can be declared as a municipal area if the average floating population added to the local population exceeds that mark.
- c:- At least 70% of the population must be dependent primarily on occupation other than agricultural practices.
- d:- The area must have the facilities of Banks, shopping centres, higher secondary school, Primary Health Centres, potable water supply system, Telephone exchange, parks, cremation ground/graveyards, adequate Government or common land for future development etc.
- e:- Any such local area must have the capacity to generate adequate revenue for running the expenses of the Municipal Committee.


