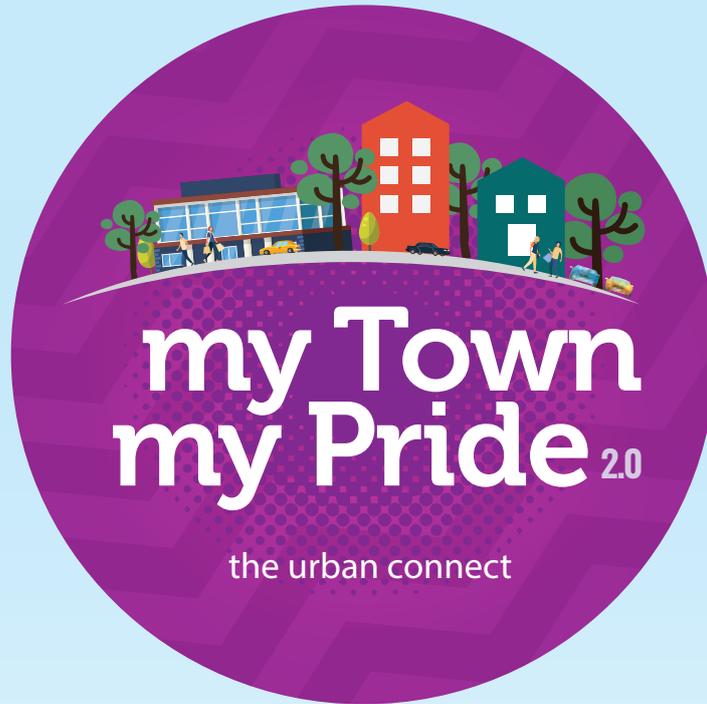



## 1. Overview

Beautification is the improvement of the visual appearance and aesthetics of the City. This can range from simple, purely visual elements, such as annual planting and colorful banners, to functional elements such as street lighting, furniture, and tree planting, as well as major infrastructure projects such as road and sidewalk creation and restoration. A beautiful City can be the source of great civic pride. Also, it is self-perpetuating. The more residents feel their community of which to be proud, the more they are willing to invest in improving it further. City beautification is important for tourism and improves the quality of life of its residents as well.

## 2. Issues/Concerns

The major issues that needs to be addressed to enhance aesthetics of the city are :

- Insensitive addition and alterations in the built form.
- Non-compliance to development control regulations.
- Visual clutter of physical infrastructure like electrical wires and communication cables.
- Lack of appropriate planning and policy for city beautification.
- Getting approvals for work from multiple private ownership.
- Weak operation and maintenance strategy of public infrastructure.
- Changing the mindset of people towards a new concept and getting them onboard.


