At the outset the Member Secretary, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) welcomed all the members and apprised members that the Shelter for Urban Homeless is one of the important component of NULM. This component of NULM will focus on providing shelter to people who are living either on roadside or under flyovers or they lodge themselves in the homes of their relatives with not sufficient space to live in. The state has projected the construction of two such shelters one each in Jammu and Kupwara districts of the state in 2015-16. The shelters made in these two districts will provide accommodation for men, women and families. Facilities like dining hall, common kitchen, care taker, separate bathrooms and toilets for men and women and common dormitory will be included in these shelters. The Nodal Officer (NULM) inform that the facility so created shall be transitory in

where as the food shall be provided on subsidized rates as per the guidelines of schemes. The occupants of the shelter should not be necessarily a state subject of the state. After discussing the availability of land and facilities provided in these shelters, chairman Project Sanctioning Committee conveyed his approval for the construction of both shelters each at Kupwara and Jammu for which the estimated costs will be Rs.175.00 and Rs.196.25 lacs respectively and desired that the execution shall be completed in the time bound manner so that facility is made available to the deserving people at the earliest.

Commissioner/ Secretary H&UDD while congratulating the efforts of DUDA Kupwara and Jammu for identifying and finalizing the projects in their respective DUDA's, also pressed for the construction of such shelters in other districts like Srinagar, Samba, Budgam, Reasi and Kathua. The DULB, Jammu assured that he will make 2 kanals of land available near bus stand at Kathua for the construction of shelter for urban homeless. The commissioner/secretary H&UDD also informed that the management of the shelter shall be done by DUDA in association with NGOs/ Trusts and occupants of the shelter shall be also be taken aboard in deciding the operation and management of shelters.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks.
